

## MINUTES

### THUNDERBIRD PROPERTY OWNER'S ASSOCIATION

July 9, 2018

The meeting was called to order by President Bette LoBue at 7:00 P.M. There were 24 homeowners present. The invocation was led by Bette and Bill Piel led the flag salute.
